

Ware helps with Back to School

The center for Women and Families were in need of backpacks for the children who are living at the shelter here in Louisville, Kentucky. Ware and their employees donated 22 backpacks completely filled with: paper, notebooks, composition books, pens, pencils, markers, scissors, pencil pouch, erasers, colored pencils, crayons, glue or glue sticks, folders, dictionary, stapler, ruler, index cards and calculators. All the school supplies a child would need to head back to school.

Dale Herink, VP of Development said excitedly “We’ve received backpacks from other donors before, but never filled with so many supplies.”

The Center for Women and Families serves women, children and families affected by domestic violence, rape/sexual assault and economic hardship.
